Resolution of Recognition, Appreciation and Affection**

Whereas, Filmore Paul Bordelon, Jr., M.D., affectionately known as “Dr. F.P.” served as a member of the Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners from 1974 until his death on May 5, 2004; and

Whereas, Dr. F.P. was elected in 1988, by his fellow Board members, to serve as Chairman of the Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners, a position he held uninterruptedly until his death; and

Whereas, his energy and enthusiasm for life allowed him to serve the LSBPNE while simultaneously serving on a multitude of other State Boards, Commissions and Associations; and

Whereas, the Citizens of Louisiana have benefitted greatly from his service to these Agencies, as well as from his distinguished medical career; and

Whereas, Dr. F.P. was a champion of practical nursing education and practice in the State of Louisiana and was particularly mindful of the Board’s responsibility to ensure the clinical competency of practical nursing graduates; and

Whereas, his support of key legislation has allowed the Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners to continue to fulfill its mission of public protection; and

Whereas, his absence will be deeply felt by those who knew and loved him, for his incomparable style and wit endeared him to all;

Therefore, Be It Resolved:

That the Members and Staff of the Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners express their heartfelt gratitude for the contributions of Dr. F.P. to the work of the Board and their sorrow on the loss of a great man; and

That a copy of this resolution be spread upon the pages of the permanent records of the Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners so that it becomes a part of the history of the Board.
