Dear Ms. Stampley:

The Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners has received a report regarding your practice as a licensed practical nurse. The report is concerning an incident that occurred at St. Francisville Country Manor. You were employed as a licensed practical nurse with the facility on July 6, 2017. It alleges that on August 2, 2018, you worked the 6:00pm to 6:00am shift. During this shift, you were assigned to the care of resident R.M. and were assigned the task of orienting a new practical nurse employee. It is reported that the resident sustained two falls during the shift. You were present for each fall and assisted the resident from the floor. However, you failed to complete an incident report, failed to document in the nursing notes, and failed to notify the physician or oncoming staff. In addition, you failed to properly orient the new employee to the policies and procedures regarding incidents. During the investigation, you admitted to administering Tylenol to the patient after he complained of right leg pain. However, you failed to document administration of said medication in the resident's medical chart. On August 3, 2018, an X-ray was ordered following the resident's complaint of hip pain. The X-ray revealed the resident sustained an intertrochanteric fracture of the right femur. Video surveillance of your shift on August 2, 2018, was reviewed as part of the investigation. It was discovered that you brought your two children to work with you and allowed them to sit in the nurse's station during your shift. Video surveillance also showed you in the nurse's station covered with your head down. You were previously counseled for failure to follow policies and procedure for calling-in for your assigned shift and a no-call, no-show on February 27, 2018. Your employment was terminated from the facility.

A review of the board's licensing records revealed that your practical nursing license expired on January 31, 2018. Therefore, you practiced as a licensed practical nurse without a valid license to do so.

Louisiana Revised Statutes, 49:961 (C), in pertinent part, provides: "If the agency finds that public health, safety, or welfare imperatively requires emergency action, and incorporates a finding to the effect in its order, summary suspension of a license may be ordered pending proceedings for revocation or other action." LSA-R.S. 49:961(C).

The Board has determined that the allegations against you are sufficiently serious to **summarily suspend your LPN license**, in accordance with the above cited authority, and hereby, issues the following Order:

**ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that based on the information and/or record(s) obtained by the Louisiana State Board of Practical Nurse Examiners, and a finding "that public health, safety, or welfare imperatively requires emergency action", in accordance with LSA-R.S. 49:961(C), the LPN license of the above named respondent, **Brandi Stampley**, is hereby summarily suspended, pending proceedings for revocation or other action, in accordance with Louisiana law.

**You must immediately cease and desist the practice of practical nursing.**

The Board will schedule your case for the next available formal hearing and will notify you by mail of the date and time. Moreover, the Board will continue its investigation of the allegations against you, about which you will be notified by Formal Complaint, to determine if you are in violation of the following:

3. **being unfit, or incompetent by reason of negligence, habit or other causes;**
6. **practicing practical nursing without being duly licensed to do so by the board;**
7. **using in connection with his/her name any designation tending to imply that he/she is a practical nurse without being duly licensed to practice by the board;**
8. **being guilty of unprofessional conduct;**
  - a. **failure to practice practical nursing in accordance with the standards normally expected;**
  - b. **failure to utilize appropriate judgment in administering nursing practice;**
  - c. **failure to exercise technical competence in carrying out nursing care;**

- j. intentionally committing any act that adversely affects the physical or psychosocial welfare of the patient;**
- o. being guilty of moral turpitude;**
- p. inappropriate, incomplete or improper documentation;**
- t. violating any provisions of R.S. 37:961 et seq. (the practical nursing practice act), as amended or aiding or abetting therein.**

**Louisiana Revised Statute, Title 37, Chapter 11. Nurses, Part II. Practical Nurses, Section 969, et. seq.**

**And, The Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 37, Chapter 11, Part II, Section 978. A:**

- (3) Practice practical nursing unless duly licensed to do so under the provisions of this Part;**
- (4) Use in connection with his name any designation tending to imply that he is a practical nurse, unless licensed to practice under the provisions of this Part;**
- (8) Violate any provisions of this Part.**

Furthermore, you should immediately submit to our office a detailed narrative response to the allegations.
